# **EASTER DAY LENT LITURGY**

#### "FROM TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH"

On this Resurrection Day, we transform the Lenten Cross of suffering into the radiancy of the new life Christ has won for all who believe.

We remove from the cross the **bread and wine**, symbols of the body of Christ broken, the blood of Christ shed for you and me.

We remove from the cross the **bowl and towel** that remind us that Jesus, the King of heaven and earth became a servant to us all.

We remove from the cross the **bag of money**, thirty pieces of silver that remind us that we sold Christ for our own ends.

We remove from the cross the **purple robe and the crown of thorns** with which we mocked the Saviour Jesus.

We remove from the cross the **whip** with which we scourged Christ.

We remove from the cross the **palm branches** that remind us of the fickleness of people who hailed Jesus as king, just a week before they shouted 'Crucify!'

We remove from the cross the **nails** that held our Saviour to the tree.

Very early on Sunday morning, the women went to the tomb carrying the spices they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the entrance to the tomb, so they went in, but they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. They stood there puzzled about this, when suddenly, two men in bright, shining clothes stood by them. Full of fear, the women bowed down to the ground as the men said to them: 'WHY ARE YOU LOOKING AMONG THE DEAD FOR HE WHO IS ALIVE? HE IS NOT HERE; HE HAS BEEN RAISED '.
